

#### Message from Bishop Wm. Crean

Pope Francis has asked us to promote parish conversations about his document,

#### The Joy of Love (Amoris Laetitia),

as part of our preparations for the World Meeting of Families. To facilitate these parish conversations the national WMOF18 team has already sent some of the written course material to parishes with some video material to follow and it is envisaged that the series of six parish conversations will happen next spring, maybe around the period of lent.

Families and others from all over the world will gather in Dublin From 21-26 August 2018 to

celebrate their lives together, to share their experiences from different parts of the world, to reflect on the different challenges they face and to grow together in faith.

The theme chosen by Pope Francis for WMOF2018 is The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World. The WMOF2018 Logo, launched in December 2016, reflects on this theme and our journey towards August 2018.
