Registration and Tickets

At the moment the tickets for the Festival of Families in Croke Park and the **Closing Mass** in Phoenix Park are not directly available on general release until we have completed our consultations with the relevant statutory agencies on capacity, transport, security, safety and other issues. Pastoral Congress

Registrations for the WMOF2018 Pastoral Congress have now exceeded 18,000 people. Approximately 60% of these registrations are from overseas with the remaining 40% being registrations from within Ireland. We are on target to have somewhere between 10,000 - 12,000 international visitors to the WMOF2018 which will mean that we will have the largest international attendance at the World Meeting of Families gathering to date.
