On behalf of the Steering Committee of Adult Studies of the Catechism we are delighted to confirm that Dr. Petroc Willey¹, Professor of Catechetics at Franciscan University of Steubenville will address Spiritual Directors, Facilitators and Students of Catechism Studies (past/present/future) at Our Lady's Shrine, Knock on Friday and Saturday 20th and 21st April 2018. We have decided on two days so as to allow people to attend on Friday or Saturday depending on personal circumstances.

Our hope is that Petroc's visit will inspire many people to take seriously the commitment to form study groups. We strongly encourage you to seek out new potential 'students' and to invite them to join with us (e.g. members of Parish Pastoral Councils, Teachers of R.E., Catholic School Principals, all involved in Faith Formation home/school/parish).

His Excellency Archbishop Jude Thaddeus Okolo, Papal Nuncio to Ireland, has confirmed his hope and strong desire to be with us on both days. An invitation has been issued to each of our Diocesan Bishops.
